Where? – Gradbach Scout Camp Site

When? – Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July – Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2026

Who? – Squirrels and Beavers from the High Peak District

How much? – £15

## Booking and Payment

Booking and payment will take place on the website Ticket Source. Places are limited to 20 Squirrels and 40 Beavers and we expect tickets to sell fast. Once all tickets have been sold, you will be able to add your child to a waiting list. Bookings will open at 10:00 on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March and will close at 23:55 on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April. It will not be possible to book a place or add your child to the waiting list after this date. A link to the booking page can be found on the 'Squirrel and Beaver Birthday Bash' page of the High Peak Scouting website. Alternatively, you can search for the event on Ticket Source. Please be aware, there is a £1.17 booking fee.

### Note:

- When asked to chose a 'seat' you will see there are 12 rows. The top 4 are for Squirrel places and the bottom 8 are for Beaver places. Whilst the seat itself doesn't matter, please only book the row relevant to your child's section. If all the 'seats' for your child's section have sold out, then unfortunately there are no places left.
- *If booking for both a Squirrel and Beaver.* When you are asked to give the booker's and attendee's details, you will be shown a screen similar to the one below.

Your Beaver should be the 1<sup>st</sup> attendee (in this example; James) and your Squirrel should be the 2<sup>nd</sup> attendee (in this example; Jill).

### Drop Off/Pick Up

Gradbach Scout Camp is at the end of a country lane. Those who have visited the site before will know that this lane can get quite busy, especially during the Summer months and when there are events at Gradbach. Therefore, you'll be given a 15-minute time window to drop off and pick up. We ask that you do not arrive at Gradbach before the start of the window and leave before the end of the window. Event staff will guide traffic along the lane in an effort to make the process as easy as possible. To help reduce the number of vehicles dropping off, we strongly encourage car sharing. If you're car sharing with someone who has a different drop off/pick up time, please tell us so we know and we can change times around. When dropping off, you will be asked to confirm who will be collecting your child after the camp. A one-way system will be in operation around Gradbach Scout Camp.

### Catering

The camp fee includes the evening meal and breakfast. Squirrels/Beavers will need to bring their own packed lunch with them for Saturday lunchtime (Please do not pack any nut-containing products). Pick up is around midday on Sunday, so lunch will not be provided. Over the course of the weekend, they'll have access to fresh fruit as a snack. There are taps supplying drinking water around Gradbach, so please make sure your child comes with a water bottle (this is on the kit list).

### Kit List

The document linked below is the kit list for the event. It's got a handy tick-list so you know what has gone into your Squirrel/Beaver's bag. Please involve your child with the packing process so they know what they have and where it is. If your child is bringing a sleeping bag or roll mat that has its own bag, encourage your child to learn to put it away as this will help greatly in the morning.

### Health and Consent Form

Within a week of booking your child's place, you will be sent a link to the Health and Consent Form. This allows you to provide the contact details of the primary and emergency contact, and to inform us of any medical conditions or dietary requirements that your child has. If necessary, a member of the camp team will get in touch to discuss any of these conditions or requirements. It is essential that this form is filled by Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April. When adding your child's emergency contact, please be aware they must be available throughout the duration of the camp should they need to be contacted by the camp team or make their way to Gradbach.
